This will be the 25th Anniversary of The Dream Ride Experience. What started out as a motorcycle ride throughout the Farmington countryside to bring awareness of those living in our communities with Intellectual Disabilities has grown into a 3-day event that is attended by thousands from all over the United States and other countries. Please join The Hometown Foundation and help make Dream Ride Experience Weekend 2025 the best ever!

Before submitting your vendor application, please review the rules and guidelines below and then submit the signed application. Applications will not be accepted after **August 15**, **2025**. Once approved, insurance information must be submitted.

Reminder: This is an application process. Once applications are accepted, we will follow up and provide you with payment information and any other necessary requirements.





Rules and Guidelines:

Alcohol: No outside alcoholic beverages may be brought onto, sold, or consumed on the Farmington Polo Club property or parking lots, unless bought or sold on-site from verified vendors. No outside food products may be sold on the property.

Food will not be provided to vendors. There are multiple food options on-site.

Booth Space Location: Once a spot has been assigned, we cannot change it. If you are looking for a particular location, you may put in a request but it is not guaranteed. All location spaces are final and will not be moved day of. If you have any special requests, please let us know before the event so that we can best meet your needs.

Electricity and Equipment: All vendors must provide their own equipment (tents, chairs, tables, etc.) Equipment will not be provided. Electricity is not provided but may be purchased. Please see the following vendor application. Vendors should provide battery-powered lighting for their booths.

Hours: Friday, August 22 from 4 p.m. to 10 p.m.; Saturday, August 23 from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m.; Sunday, August 24 from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. All booths must be staffed during all the vending hours of the event.

Insurance: **ALL** vendors must provide The Dream Ride Experience/The Hometown Foundation, Inc. with a signed original Certificate of Insurance (ACORD Form) **no later than August 15, 2025. Coverage is required to attend the event.** Coverage requirements are included at the end of this packet.

Overnight: No overnight parking or camping is permitted on-site at The Farmington Polo Club or at The Farmington Club.

Parking Pass: Each vendor will receive ONE parking pass for entry to park on-site. Parking spaces first come first serve, please plan arrival accordingly. Upon initial setup, you will be able to drive to your designated space, unload equipment, and return to park in general parking. All other guests and spectator parking is OFF-SITE with shuttles available.

Pets: No pets or animals, except registered service animals and animals adopted from the 2025 Dream Ride Pet Adoption Center, are allowed on the Farmington Polo Club property.

Refunds: No refunds will be given once The Dream Ride Experience vendor application has been accepted. No refunds will be made contingent on the weather. This event is rain or shine.

Security: There will be overnight security, and booths may be left set-up overnight; however, the Dream Ride Experience will not be held accountable for any injury, property damage, theft or vandalism.

Set up and Breakdown: General booth setup will take place from 11:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. on Friday, August 22. If you are not on-site by 2:30 p.m., you will not be able to vend at The Dream Ride Experience and forfeit your payment. Breakdown of exhibits may not start until 4 p.m. on Sunday, August 24.

The Hometown Foundation, Inc. Vendor Insurance Requirements 2025 Each Vendor is required to provide proof of insurance on an ACORD certificate of Liability Insurance with the following information & insurance coverage: Coverages:

- General Liability: \$1,000,000 per occurrence/ \$2,000,000 aggregate required. A separate aggregate limit of \$2,000,000 shall be provided for products and completed operations.
- If applicable, Liquor Liability with a per occurrence limit of \$1,000,000 / \$2,000,000 aggregate.
- If applicable, Automobile Liability: \$1,000,000 CSL including all owned, leased, hired and non-owned automobiles.
- Umbrella Liability: \$3,000,000 per occurrence/ \$3,000,000 aggregate required. Policy should be on a follow-form basis with the same coverages as the underlying policies.
- Worker's Compensation and Employer's Liability: \$1,000,000 E.L. Each accident, \$1,000,000 E.L Each Disease-EA Employee, \$1,000,000 E.L Disease- Policy Limit.
